Case Manager works with the OPP, to assess and provide direct intervention or referral to appropriate service providers/programs, for clients on issues related to: addictive patterns of behavior; concurrent disorders; and other mental health, behavioral and emotional concerns such as abuse, violence, grief and loss,

Qualifications:

- Masters, Bachelors or Diploma in the area of Social Work, Psychology, Social Services, Drug and Alcohol, or other Human Services.
- Registration with the Ontario College of Social Workers and Social Service Workers (if a social worker) or another recognized professional counselling college is required.
- Current knowledge of child protection/ reportability requirements.
- Knowledge of Trauma Informed Care.
- Minimum 2 years related experience preferred.
- Excellent interpersonal skills and communication skills.
- Experience working with First Nations an asset.
