The Rehabilitation Assistant will assist in the provision of clinical care and education to clients by delivering treatment interventions for coping with limitations in movement, daily functioning and activity.

- Physical Therapy/Occupational Therapy Assistant (PTA/OTA) certificate or diploma, Kinesiology degree or related field required.
- Previous experience working with clients in a health care facility preferred.
- Basic computer knowledge/skills required.
- Ability to communicate effectively, both orally and in writing.
- Ability to work collaboratively in an interprofessional team environment.
