The summer student will work in collaboration with other disciplines to ensure Resident care plan are focused with achievable goals, which promote maintenance of optimal function and independence, foster healthy relationships in the facility and community, and provide appropriate social stimulation and leisure activities suitable for residents' abilities. Activities will be planned, implemented and evaluated to ensure the inclusion of rehabilitative principles, maintenance of optimal health and emotional well being of Residents and the participation of family and community.
