Student Summer Employment

The Sioux Lookout Meno Ya Win Health Centre encourages and supports employment opportunities for summer employment for students who are enrolled in studies within the health care field.

Through funding opportunities such as those sponsored by Northern Ontario School of Medicine students may make application to be considered for 6 to 8 week programs. We apply for student funding for areas in nursing, laboratory, and pharmacy. The student enrolled in an education program within the funded area must **apply to NOSM** in order to be considered for this program.

Students who wish to work at any position within the hospital may apply for general summer employment. An **application with a cover letter** expressing summer employment and the area of interest will be considered.

Student Placements

The Sioux Lookout Meno Ya Win Health Centre also supports and provides placement/consolidation opportunities for students who are enrolled in studies within the health care field. The student must provide a **resume to the hospital with cover letter** expressing the term of the placement and the field of study. Human Resources together with the manager will determine if there is a placement opportunity. The student is then notified and in turn must notify the school to complete further requirements of the placement. We have provided placements for students completing studies in nursing and administrative assistant. This is an educational opportunity for students to gain experience in the health field.

Student Coop (Work Education)

The Sioux Lookout Meno Ya Win Health Centre also supports and provides opportunities for high school students to complete their required work education (community placement) hours in a health care setting. The High School education counselor together with the student will contact the hospital to request the placement. Human Resources together with the manager will determine if there is a placement opportunity. The student is then notified and in turn must notify the school to complete further requirements of the placement. This is another educational opportunity for students to obtain experience in health services.
